New Student Induction

The school conducted a structured induction programme to welcome newly admitted students and orient them to campus life. Key areas addressed during the programme

Orientation Session – Students were introduced to the school's vision, academic structure, and available support systems.

Rules and Code of Conduct – Norms related to attendance, punctuality, uniform, discipline, and digital behaviour were explained.

Daily Schedule and Calendar – Timetables, academic calendars, assessment plans, and assembly routines were shared.

School Culture and Values – Core values such as respect, integrity, inclusivity, and discipline were highlighted.

AI Training For Teachers

Title: Empowering Educators through AI Tools in Teaching

Date: 14/6/2025

Venue: COMPUTER SCIENCE LAB

Presented by: Dr. Shanmugavel, SRM Eswari Engineering college

INTRODUCTION

With the rapid advancement of artificial intelligence (AI), the field of education is undergoing a significant transformation. To empower educators and enhance teaching methodologies, a workshop titled “AI Tools in Teaching” was conducted.



Key Sessions and Tools Demonstrated

I. ChatGPT – AI Lesson Planning and Content Support

The workshop began with an introduction to ChatGPT, an AI chatbot that assists educators in creating customized lesson plans, quizzes, reading material, and summaries. Participants observed how ChatGPT can instantly generate a structured lesson plan, such as a Grade 8 Science topic on “Water Cycle,” along with learning outcomes, engaging activities, and assessment questions. Teachers appreciated how the tool can be adapted to different subjects and student levels.

The session aimed to introduce teachers to a range of AI-based tools that support lesson planning, content creation, video production, reading access, and voice-based teaching resources. The focus was on hands-on application of tools such as ChatGPT, MagicSchool.ai, InVideo, Z-Library, Eleven Labs, and MagicHour AI.

2. MagicSchool.ai – Tailored specifically for educators, this tool supports teachers with ready-to-use lesson plans, scaffolding strategies, parent email templates, and even IEP support. Attendees explored its features and created a lesson plan on “Democratic Government” for Class 6, which included differentiated instructions, activity suggestions, and formative assessments.



3. InVideo – AI Video Creation Tool

The session on InVideo demonstrated how AI can convert simple text into professional-quality videos. Teachers generated educational videos with background music, narration, and animations. A short video on “Photosynthesis” was created during the session.

4. Z-Library – Free Digital Learning Resource


Z-Library, a vast online repository of free academic books, where Educators explored how to access supplementary reading material, reference books, and textbooks to enrich lesson content.

5. Eleven Labs – AI Text-to-Speech Generator- allows users to input text and produce natural-sounding speech in multiple voices and languages. Useful for creating audio lessons, supporting visually impaired learners.

6. MagicHour AI – AI Image & Visual Creation Tool an AI-based visual content creator to generate educational posters, diagrams, and story visuals by simply entering a topic. A poster on “Environmental Conservation” was generated in real-time,

Feedback and Conclusion

Participants found the workshop highly informative and practical. They were enthusiastic about integrating AI tools into their teaching to reduce workload, increase creativity, and improve student interaction.

- To equip participants with basic skills in eco-friendly art-making




ACTIVITIES CONDUCTED

We extend our heartfelt appreciation to these talented students for their remarkable achievement, reflecting the school's commitment to nurturing talent and promoting healthy competition.





