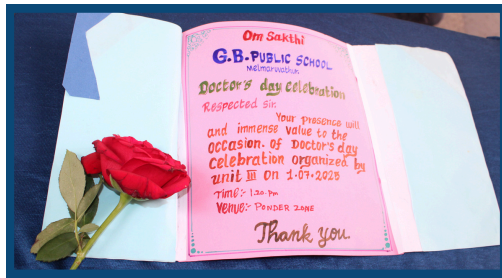


# NATIONAL DOCTOR'S DAY

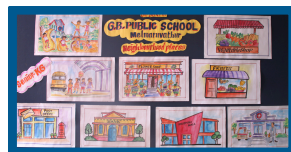
We congratulate all participants for their active involvement and look forward to more such enriching opportunities that inspire responsible citizenship and creativity.
