This activity enhances leadership skills, public speaking, critical thinking, teamwork, and civic responsibility, encouraging students to become informed and responsible citizens.



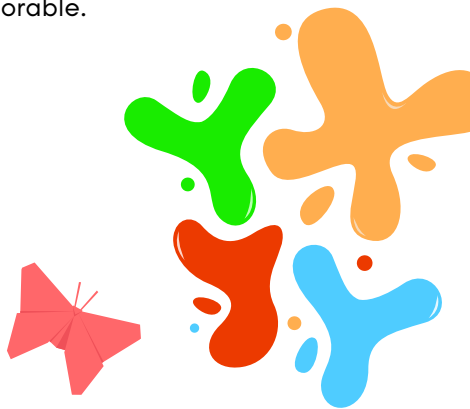

# Maths Drawing Competition- 06.12.2025

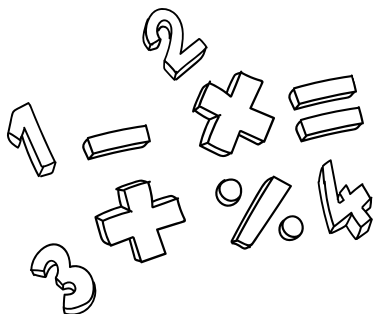
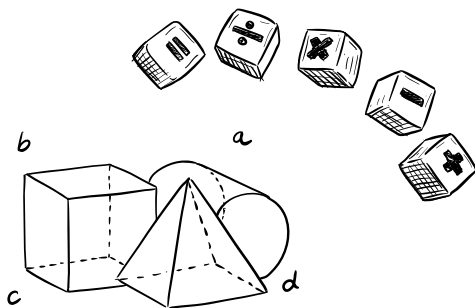
## Where Art Meets Mathematics - Unit III

This activity helped develop visual thinking, imagination, accuracy, and appreciation for mathematics, making learning both fun and meaningful.



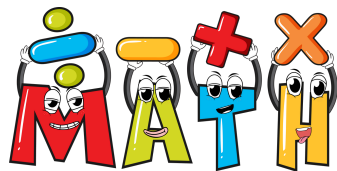

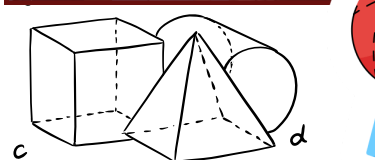
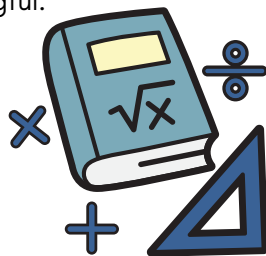
MATHEMATICS EXPO - UNIT I & UNIT II
